



Ancil Hoffman – May 6, 2023

The challenges of the weather over the past few months continued for the Carmichael Golf Club (CGC) event at Ancil Hoffman on May 6, 2023.

After some signs of Spring over the previous couple of weeks, this day started out with overnight rains that lingered with a dampness through most of the morning hours. An initial group of 24 players stayed pretty positive about the prospects of the day, and the 20 players who braved the conditions (and the ever promising forecast as the day progressed) were rewarded with improving conditions after some intermittent showers in the early holes.

Ancil has become another early season CGC favorite for a couple of reasons – 1) its' central location works well when weather concerns are highest, and 2) without Spring aeration, the greens are generally better than most courses at this early time of the season.

On this day, just about every weather condition was met (showers early, some wind, sun most of the back nine). Adjusting to the various conditions throughout the round was much more important the quality of the scoring – we are so appreciative of the support of the group to make it through this day without us having to disrupt our future 2023 CGC schedule any further!!

Having said that, it was another rough overall scoring day for the group. Only 1 of the 20 players shot a net score better than par 72. Ten (10) players shot scores of net 80 or higher.
