



Bing Maloney – July 15, 2023

Bing Maloney has become one of the Carmichael Golf Club's (CGC) steadiest Summer options – reasonable costs, walking options, a fair golf track without a lot of hazards, and usually the ability to get early tee times to beat the Summer heat.

With a new Tournament Director in play at Bing as we were finalizing our 2023 schedule, we had to settle for about an hour later start than we normally request – and that earlier hour would have been greatly appreciated on this day!! Again, we found ourselves on one of the hotter days of a heat pattern, the temperature reaching 100 before our final groups finished around 2:00P (on the way to a high of 105+).

Just a hint of breeze throughout the day made it manageable for our group of 24 golfers – who were in good spirits and worked their way around the golf course in a timely manner. Again, we didn't push the tee box options – getting around the course safely and efficiently was much more important.

From a golfing standpoint, this was actually the best scoring round for the group so far in 2023 CGC events. A review of the scorecards indicates a lot of steady, not spectacular, play. Three (3) players shot scores of less than net par 72, while six (6) players shot scores of net 80 or higher.
