CGC Recap - Ancil Hoffman, April 28, 2018

Our event on this day is our first of two events at Ancil in 2018 - after canceling our November 2017 Ancil event on a day that ended up being 'playable', it was important to maintain our relationship with the course going forward - we felt scheduling 2 events in 2018 would help in that regard. With a six week gap since our 2018 season opening event at Teal Bend, this day also felt like a 'second chance' beginning to our 2018 CGC season.

The course was in good shape - though the greens, with a little bit of a sandy base and some firmness, were a little 'table-top' in spots. With mature trees lining fairways, the ability to keep your ball in play will save you strokes here - with many of the punch shots out of the trees needing to either go sideways or are limited in advancing down the fairway.

We ended up with a classic Spring-like day weather wise, with temperatures in the upper 60's/ low 70's - with periods of sun and periods of clouds, and multiple occasions to either put on or take off jackets.

By utilizing many of the tee box options for different handicap flights, we feel that we found the right combination to make the golfing part of the day both enjoyable, while challenging, for a majority of the group. Eight (8) players shot scores of lower than net par 72 (with 6 scores in the net 60's) - with another four (4) players shooting net par 72. Six (6) players shot scores of net 80 or higher.
