

## **CGC RECAP - BING MALONEY, AUGUST 18, 2018**

Bing Maloney checks off many boxes for our group as we set up our yearly schedules - good cost, gentle course layout, early tee time capability in the Summer, local (especially when scheduled in the near term around our yearly away trip).

Bing has done a good job in recent years of giving players a good steady product - you know what your going to get, the course is not tricked up, with generally good greens. To more easily maintain the course, recent subtractions (like the removal of the pond on 3, and now the front green side bunker on 11) make the course even more playable and susceptible to good scores.

The early tee times definitely came in handy on this day - not a terribly hot day, but as you got to the latter stages of the round, you were glad you were on the 16th hole instead of the 6th hole at that time of day. Twenty two (22) of the thirty two (32) players on this day had made the Monterey trip - and the return to Valley golf was a welcome sight for most players' games. Twelve (12) of the 32 players shot scores of lower than net par 72 (with another 3 players shooting a net par 72). More noticeable, however, was that only 2 players shot scores of net 80 or higher.
