

CGC RECAP - MATHER, NOVEMBER 3, 2018

Over the past few years Mather has become a more consistent part of our CGC schedule. The efforts to improve drainage on the course has helped make it more playable for longer stretches of the season. With the dry weather we have experienced in recent weeks, the course on this day was playing shorter and faster from tee to green. The greens, on the other hand, were playing a bit slow - likely a combination of the warmer weather for this late in the season along with being at the back end of their 'post aeration'.

We had beautiful weather (upper 70's, low 80's - light breezes) for our last CGC golf event for 2018. The combination of all of the above made the course ripe for good scoring, not a bad way to end the golfing season. The 32 players on this day took advantage, as statistically Mather played the easiest of any course on our 2018 schedule.
