Upcoming 2012 CGC Events

Saturday, April 21, 2012 – Wildhawk (Tournament of Champions, rescheduled from initial date of March 17, 2012): Right now it looks like we will have a field of 36 for this event. A starting time listing will go out to the players scheduled to play in this event 4-5 days prior to this event.

Saturday, April 28, 2012 – Haggin Oaks (MacKenzie): We are still taking entries for this event through April 14, 2012.

Saturday, May 19, 2012 – Napa: We played a CGC event here for the first time in 2010, and are looking forward to returning. A request for players will go out via email in the next couple of weeks.

July 26-28, 2012 – Monterey trip: We are closing in on 50 players for this trip. A request for the balance of payment for the golf portion of this trip will be sent out via email in the next couple of weeks.

Results from Wildhorse, April 7, 2012

The Sacramento area went from Spring-like conditions during the majority of February 2012 to an unsettled weather pattern during March 2012. After two attempts to begin our Carmichael Golf Club (CGC) golfing season – March 17, 2012 at Wildhawk and March 31, 2012 at Wildhorse - on April 7, 2012 we finally got the weather we had been looking for on a weekend. Light breezes and temperatures in the mid-to-upper 60's felt ideal. Wildhorse, with its' reputation for good drainage during the wet season, played hard and fast as if we were playing in late May or early June.

We agonized some over the sets of tees to use, and overall opted for the shorter sets of tees (except for Rhonda Johnson and Doralyn McPeake in the Second Flight) in part to it being an early season event and due to the number of 'carry' shots required on this course, especially on the last few holes. With only 3 scores under net 70 and only 7 overall scores under net par, we feel this was the appropriate set up for this day.

All 5 Flight winners are our initial qualifiers for the 2013 Tournament of Champions (TOC) event. Stella Garin had the low net for the day (8 under par net 65) to win the 3rd Flight. This was closely followed by Vince Avila (5 under par net 67) in the 1st Flight, and Letitia Ruiter (5 under par net 68) in the 5th Flight. All 3 of these players won their Flight by 6 shots. Jay Jackson's 1 under par net 71 in the 2nd Flight gave him a 2 shot victory, while Debbie Rankin's 1 under par net 72 in the 4th Flight gave her a 3 stroke cushion. [NOTE: Wildhorse played to a par 72 for the Men, par 73 for the Women.]

For many reasons (course difficulty and an early season event being the main 2), this was not the day to belabor pace of play issues. Our next few events are on more straight forward courses, so we hope to see improvement in the group's pace at these events. It will be most interesting at Haggin Oaks on April 28, where the course has apparently instituted a very strict pace of play guideline, and player's assistants on the course to help maintain a reasonable pace.
