With its' reputation for drainage in the Winter months, Teal Bend is quickly becoming our traditional season opening Tournament of Champions (TOC) venue. After some heavy rains in early March, just a short dry spell before this event was enough to have the course in pretty good shape to start our 2016 season. A good weather day gave us every chance to enjoy the golf course.

Results from Rancho Solano, April 30, 2016

The Fairfield courses (Paradise Valley and Rancho Solano) both opened in the early 1990's – and have been fairly constant venues for the CGC through the years. Rancho Solano is known for its' large greens – and the main reason for those large greens is the prevailing wind that blows through the hillside surrounding the course. The course can play quite difficult with the hilly terrain.

On this day, the wind was significant – even by Rancho Solano standards! It easily was a steady 20 MPH, with gusts up to 30-35 MPH. It was evident fairly early that the course was going to win on this day – with only 8 of the 42 players shooting net scores of par 72 or lower (with only 4 scores in the net 60's), while 21 players ended up with scores of net 80 or higher.
