## **Upcoming 2016 CGC Events**

We have our Reno trip next week, then 2 events during July 2016.

Thursday June 23 through Saturday June 25, 2016 – Reno trip: 38 players scheduled to play some or all of this 3 day trip. Specific information on this trip to be sent via email to those scheduled to play in the coming days.

Saturday, July 16, 2016 – Haggin Oaks (MacKenzie): An early start (8:03A) to beat the Summer heat – we will likely send an email request for players for this event immediately after returning from the Reno trip.

*Monday, July 25, 2016 – Ancil Hoffman:* Our 2<sup>nd</sup> of 4 Monday events scheduled for 2016. This event was moved from the initially scheduled date of Monday August 1, 2016, so that we could piggyback onto the Granite Bay event hosted by Mather Golf Course on Monday August 8, 2016.

## Results from Castle Oaks, June 4, 2016

Weather was still on our minds as we played Castle Oaks on June 4. After 2 rainouts (and a near 3<sup>rd</sup> one) along with a heavy wind day so far this year at CGC events – heat was the issue on this day. Fortunately, we caught the back end of a heat wave – the overcast day made for a muggy quality that we don't normally see and feel in California, but at least it broke the worst of the heat we had felt in previous days.

For many years, Castle Oaks was the CGC's most played course – on occasion, we would end up with a second event at Castle Oaks in a year if we had rainout or cancellation issues at other courses. We've backed off a little bit in recent years – with other course options available, and a little bit of a dropoff in our Castle Oaks entries on recent visits. The course remains a challenge – not long yardage wise, but with many decisions to be made throughout the round. Of the 34 players on this day, 6 players shot net par (71 for Men, 72 for Women) or better, with only 2 scores in the net 60's. Another 6 players shot scores of net 80 or higher.

## **Results from Bing Maloney June 13, 2016**

So far in 2016, weather has been the major issue on CGC event dates. On this morning, breezy conditions made us wonder if weather again was going to be the overriding factor for the day. However, as the morning progressed, the winds seemed to settle in at a comfortable level – which actually made for a very nice June day. A fairly quiet golf course, prior to our first group teeing off, left our 27 players on this day a nice pace of play.

Bing Maloney has become a solid City owned and operated golf course. The fairways are good, the greens are good to very good. Off the fairway, you are just as likely to find hardpan and gopher holes as rough. In general, the course is right in front of you – not a lot of hazards to navigate. The cost is reasonable, and we are able to get early times during the Summer months. The whole package makes Bing a good venue for CGC events.

7 of our 27 golfers shot scores of net par (par 72) or better (with 4 scores in the net 60's), while 7 players shot scores of net 80 or higher.
