Upcoming 2014 CGC Events

Thursday-Saturday, June 26-28, 2014 – Graeagle: This is the CGC's 5th trip to the Graeagle area (2000, 2005, 2008, 2011). Forty (40) players are scheduled to play at least 2 of the 3 days.

Results from Rancho Solano, May 3, 2014

The first weekend in May brought with it some breezy conditions – accentuated by our travel towards the Delta breezes that frequently inhabit the Fairfield area. For as much as we welcome those breezes as we move towards Summer, they can wreak havoc on the golf game. Fortunately, on this day the temperature was comfortable and still left it overall as a nice Spring-like day.

Rancho Solano was truly built with these winds in mind – with its' fairly wide fairways, and probably the largest greens that we play. Those large greens can help you get on the greens quicker, but doesn't necessarily lower your overall scores. The course definitely won on this day – of our 44 players, only 3 shot better than net par 72 (a fourth was at even par net) – with 17 players shooting net 80 or higher.

The 5 Flight winners on this day became the latest group to qualify for the CGC Tournament of Champions (TOC) event in 2015. The low net of the day, 67, was shot by Christine Lodge, leading to a 6 stroke victory in the 4th Flight. This was also Christine's 1st CGC Flight victory. The other 4 Flights were more tightly contested – Jay Simi beat Mitch Johnson via the tie-breaker (net 73 in the 1st Flight), Larry Marietti shot a net 69 to win the 2nd Flight by 3 strokes, Debbie Rankin shot a net 76 to win the 3rd Flight by 1 stroke, and Jim Rohrer shot a net 71 to win the 5th Flight by 3 strokes.

Results from Wildhawk, May 19, 2014

Through the years, the turnouts for our Monday CGC events have gotten a little larger – likely a combination of more retirees and more flexible work schedules that allow folks to take days off. In the past few years, we have increased our number of Monday CGC events from 2 to 3, and more recently from 3 to 4. Our May 19 event at Wildhawk was our first Monday event of 4 scheduled in 2014.

A run of hot early May weather broke just in time for this event – and we ended up with a beautiful Spring day. The course was in good condition, and after the difficult playing conditions at Rancho Solano just a couple of weeks earlier, Wildhawk presented a gentler test. The 36 CGC players on this day took advantage – with 10 players shooting scores better than net par 72 (and another 4 players at even par net 72), while only 5 players shot scores of net 80 or higher.

The low net of the day belonged to the threesome of Jay Jackson, Rhonda Johnson and Sheila Johnson, all at net 66. Rhonda and Jay were both in the 3rd Flight, with Rhonda winning the tie-breaker. Sheila's net 66 won the 5th Flight by 4 strokes, and was her 1st CGC Flight victory. David Hazelwood won the 1st Flight by 2 strokes with a net 70. Larry Marietti continued his hot play from Rancho Solano by again winning the 2nd Flight, with his net 72 leading to a 1 stroke victory. Clark Londquist shot a net 68 to win the 4th Flight by 2 strokes. The golfing highlight of the day belonged to the group that included David Hazelwood and Mike A. Johnson – who both had in-the-leather tee shots (followed by made birdie putts) on the Par 3 4th hole, David's at 1 foot 8 inches from the cup, and Mike's at 1 foot 9 inches. Well done!!!
