Upcoming 2014 CGC Events

Thursday-Saturday, June 26-28, 2014 – Graeagle: This is the CGC's 5th trip to the Graeagle area (2000, 2005, 2008, 2011). Forty (40) players are scheduled to play at least 2 of the 3 days.

Monday, July 14, 2014 – Mather: Our 3rd of 4 Monday events in 2014. A request for players has gone out via email in the last week.

Saturday, July 26, 2014 – Teal Bend: A CGC favorite, and able to provide us an early morning summer start (7:30 AM). A request for players will go out via email in the next 2-3 weeks.

Results from Lincoln Hills (Hills), May 31, 2014

May ended much as it began, with the breezes still having quite an effect on our CGC events. Fortunately, the combination of being in the warmer Sacramento area and playing a course (Lincoln Hills – Hills course) with fairly wide fairways made the breezes a little more welcome on this day.

The Hills course at Lincoln Hills is the much fairer (and generally more enjoyable to play) course of the 2 layouts at Lincoln Hills. Good ball striking can be rewarded – with the greens having the potential to cause some problems depending on the pin locations. On this day, the course seemed to have the right mix - of our 34 players, 9 shot better than net par 72 (with another 6 players at even par net) – with 5 players shooting net 80 or higher.

The 4 Flight winners on this day became the latest group to qualify for the CGC Tournament of Champions (TOC) event in 2015. The low net of the day, 62, was shot by Mike Aceituno and Jim Holmes. Mike's net 62 won the 2nd Flight by 10 strokes over 4 players, while Jim's net 62 won the 3rd Flight by 5 strokes. Mitch Johnson had four natural birdies on his way to a net 66 to win the 1st Flight by 2 strokes, and Sylvia Cisneros shot a net 70 to win the 4th Flight by 3 strokes.

Results from Bing Maloney, June 16, 2014

Another Monday CGC event with a good turnout. Coming off another hot spell, the breezes kicked in the night before to cool things off. The wind then lessened throughout the day to leave us with a very nice late Spring day.

Bing Maloney seems to have found a nice little niche in the local public golf course scene – not spectacular in any way, but very serviceable and playable. With it's length and tree lined fairways, it's not a pushover – but good decisions can keep you from big numbers. As other courses start to struggle under the drought like conditions, Bing holds its' own very well. On this day, the 38 CGC players managed 11 rounds better than net par 72 (and another 2 players at even par net 72), while only 4 players shot scores of net 80 or higher.

The low net of the day belonged to Karen Ammons and Richard Cisneros at net 65. Since they were in the same flight (3rd), it went to the tie-breaker, which was won by Richard. Alan Rankin won the 1st Flight with a net 69 to win the Flight by 2 strokes. Erick Ammons shot a net 67 to win the 2nd Flight by 6 strokes. Jim Rohrer shot a net 68 to win the 4th Flight by 2 strokes. The golfing highlight of the day belonged to Jay Simi, who made a natural eagle 3 on the Par 5 14th hole.
