Results from Reno weekend, June 23-25, 2016

This was the CGC's 4th weekend trip to the Reno/Carson City area (previously 2003, 2010, 2013). This trip fills a niche in our away trips – the least expensive golf, with other activities to fill the 'non-golfing' hours. Along with the 3 days of golf, we had a group of 20 attend a Reno Aces Triple-A baseball game on Wednesday evening, and a good portion of the group gathered for a BBQ on Friday night.

Wolf Run – June 23, 2016

This was the third CGC event at Wolf Run (2010, 2013). This course presents a lot of challenges with many uncomfortable shots over creeks that wind through the property. On this day, that was exacerbated by a significant breeze - adding to the difficulty. By the end of the day, the golf course only yielded 3 scores under net par 72 (1 other player shot even net par), while 15 players shot scores of net 80 or higher. This rough start seemed to take a toll on the group going forward, as the overall 3 day scores were significantly higher than in 2013 – when we played the same 3 courses in the same order of play.

Red Hawk (Hills) – June 24, 2016

We discovered the 2 courses at Red Hawk as we were preparing for our Reno trip back in 2012-2013. We were not having much luck in securing courses we had played on previous trips to the Reno area. The Red Hawk courses were intriguing for various reasons, 1) with 2 courses available to the public on the property, we could 'localize' the travel, 2) the courses were distinctly different (as the names 'Hills' and 'Lakes' implies), and 3) the overall quality of the facilities would make it very comfortable (especially on the final day of the trip – with the outdoor setting just off of the 18th green of the Lakes course).

Playing from the same set of tees we played in 2013, the Hills course played much tougher in 2016. The breezes were a little calmer than the first day at Wolf Run, but they would kick up at various locations throughout the course – especially in the exposed areas near the top of the hills. There were 6-7 pin locations that bordered from difficult to bizarre, which did not help either the scoring or the pace of play. Of the 35 players on this day, there were 4 scores under net par (impressively, 3 of those scores being a net 65), with another 3 scores of even net par 71. 9 players shot net scores of 80 or higher.

Red Hawk (Lakes) – June 25, 2016

The third day of golf on this trip, at the Red Hawk Lakes course, gave us the best combination of conditions for better golf. The weather was the best of the week - a little breeze, but comfortable temperatures. The Lakes course was the most 'Sacramento' like of the courses on this trip, with fewer hills and side lies, and difficult individual shots or holes, but not long stretches of difficult shots that we saw on the other 2 courses. Also, until golf fatigue settles in, a little rhythm from playing for 3 straight days can minimize the bad holes.

The group responded with solid, if not spectacular, scoring. 7 players shot scores below net par (with the low net score of the day only reaching 69), with 1 player at even net par 72. The number of scores of net 80 or higher dropped a little from the first 2 days, with only 7 scores at these higher levels.
