Recapping 2013 CGC Events

This newsletter will address Carmichael Golf Club (CGC) events during the month of July 2013.

Results from Teal Bend, July 15, 2013

The 2013 CGC season has been about bursts of golfing activity. Due to an early season reschedule of our Micke Grove event, we ended up with 3 events in a 4 week period in late April through mid May. With our 3 day trip to Reno, we had 4 events in a 15 day period in June. Our Teal Bend event on July 15 is our first of 3 Monday events in 2013 – which will give us another 4 events in less than 5 weeks from mid July through mid August.

For mid July, we ended up with a very reasonable weather day. When we played the Tournament of Champions (TOC) at Teal Bend in March 2013, it was on the same day as an NCGA qualifier – and the pins were in difficult positions. We were interested to see how the course played this time – with 2 of our Flights playing the Combo Tees and 2 Flights playing the ‘regular’ Tees. For the 20 players on the Combo Tees, there were 5 net scores of par or better. For the 23 players on the ‘regular’ Tees, there were 13 net scores of par or better. It’s interesting to see to what 200-300 yards can make in the ability to score.

We had two first time CGC winners on this day – Geri Ford won the 4th Flight with a net score of 65, winning the 4th Flight by one stroke, and Erick Ammons won the 2nd Flight with a net 66, also winning his Flight by one stroke. Mitch Johnson apparently likes Teal Bend – he won the 1st Flight at the TOC in March, and won again on this day, his net 65 winning the 1st Flight by 6 strokes. The closest Flight on this day was the 3rd Flight, with 5 players within 1 stroke of each other (net’s 67 and 68). Mike Agrippino won the tie-breaker over Clark Londquist and Errol Thomas to win the 3rd Flight. The victories for Geri, Erick and Mike assured them their spot in the 2014 TOC – Mitch, Clark and Errol had all previously qualified for the TOC

Results from Bing Maloney, July 27, 2013

Another early morning start to beat the Summer heat – though this day turned out to be pretty nice, by Sacramento Summer standards. Being the only local Saturday CGC event during this period (since Turkey Creek in early June, we've been to Reno and had a Monday event, with another Monday event and Mare Island in Vallejo in the coming weeks), one of our larger turnouts (54 players) played Bing Maloney on this day.

In the past 3-4 years, Bing has made consistent improvement to the quality of the course – it's an old-style layout that's a fair and challenging test. A good round is rewarded, and it's generally not too penal if your not playing well. On this day 19 players broke net par (with another 8 players at even par net 72), with only 6 scores of net 80 or higher.

Two of the 5 Flight winners on this day were first time winners in 2013 – Joanne Briggs won her first overall CGC event with the low net score of the day, her net 55 winning the 5th Flight by 9 strokes. Gary Borge punched his ticket to the 2014 TOC, winning the 3rd Flight by 3 strokes with a net 64. Scott Battenburg took the 1st Flight with a net 67 – his chip in birdie on 18 gave him a 1 stroke victory. Ken Worman shot a net 65 to take the 2nd Flight by 1 stroke. Mike Agrippino continued his turnaround from an early season slump to take the 4th Flight by 5 strokes with a net 67.
