#### **Recapping 2014 CGC Events**

This newsletter will address Carmichael Golf Club (CGC) events on our Graeagle trip during June 2014.

#### Results from Graeagle weekend, June 26-28, 2014

This was the CGC's 5<sup>th</sup> weekend trip to the Graeagle area (previously 2000, 2005, 2008, 2011). The quiet mountain setting, nearby golf courses, and the availability of housing for us to provide a BBQ get-together for the group during our stay have made this destination a nice compliment to our Monterey and Reno trips. #### Plumas Pines – June 26, 2014

The shortest, and the tightest, of the 3 courses played this weekend – Plumas Pines has historically played the most difficult of the Graeagle area courses. This day bordered on cool – with cloudy skies, a constant breeze, and temperatures in the low 70's. Only 5 of the 38 golfers on this day broke net par, with 15 players shooting net 80 or higher.

#### Whitehawk Ranch – June 27, 2014

Going from the tight feel of Plumas Pines to the open valley as you begin your round at Whitehawk Ranch is quite a contrast! For the most part, even when you enter the tree-lined holes at Whitehawk Ranch the golf course has a more forgiving feel. The breezes were still noticeable, especially on the valley holes, but fewer clouds and a little warmer on this day. The group seemed to warm up to the golf a little bit also – with 6 of the 36 players shooting better than net par, but only 4 scores of net 80 or higher.

The day's best round was shot by Judi Ferreira, with a net 64 to win the  $3^{rd}$  Flight by 11 strokes. #### **Graeagle Meadows – June 28, 2014**

Graeagle Meadows is the original golf course in this area – other than crossing the river a couple of times on the front nine, no real tricks, the course is right out in front of you. It generally plays quite long, so we took advantage of recent Combo Tees established by the course (with some modifications) to try and help make the course a little more playable and enjoyable for our group. We had the best weather day of the trip this day – with no clouds in the sky, still a little breezy, but very comfortable temperatures. The course still got the best of the group on this day – with only 5 scores under net par among the 39 players, with 11 scores of net 80 or higher.

The low net score of the day, 69, was shot by 3 players – Jack Dever, Judi Ferreira and Jay Jackson. Jack and Jay were both in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Flight, with Jay winning the tie-breaker. Judi's net 69 won the 3<sup>rd</sup> Flight by 4 strokes.
