Results from Hiddenbrooke October 12, 2013

Our final CGC Monday event in 2013. In the past few years, Ancil Hoffman created more tee options across the board (back tees (with many newly built tees) at 7,000 yards, shifting the Whites to Blues, shifting the Reds to Whites, then creating 2 shorter sets of tees (Black from existing tee boxes and Green from newly built tees). This has given us more options for the group – the trick is to find the mix of tees to challenge our members and allow them to enjoy their round. On this day, a Combo set of tees (mix of Blue and White Tees) for the Men – and some Black or Green Tees (based on handicap levels) for the Women seemed to work pretty well.

5 of the 26 players this day shot scores below net par (with only one score below net 70), with another 4 players at net par. Nine scores of net 80 or higher were shot on the day. Two of the 4 Flight winners on this day became the next group to qualify for the CGC Tournament of Champions (TOC) event in 2014. The low net score of the day, 59, was shot by Tom Haltom in the 4th Flight, winning the Flight by 21 strokes – this was Tom's fourth CGC Flight victory in 2013. New 2014 TOC qualifiers included guest Ron Payne, whose net 71 won the 2nd Flight by 1 stroke, and Rick Givans - who shot a net 70 to win the 3rd Flight by 2 strokes. Mike A. Johnson won his second CGC Flight victory of 2013, with his net 70 winning the First Flight by 1 stroke.

Results from Mather, November 2, 2013

While Castle Oaks has been one of the CGC's most played venues through the years, in recent years the turnout for our events at Castle Oaks have lessened – it seems to be one of those courses that, while challenging, folks are willing to miss. It's likely a combination of difficulty, cost, location, and being over scheduled by the CGC. We will look at how often we schedule events at Castle Oaks in the coming years.

For the 36 players who played on this date, they faced the additional challenge of rain – not something we normally expect in September! Fortunately, the entire group got through 9 holes before the rains hit in earnest. This left between 3 and 9 holes that the groups played in the rain, which came in the form of showers (short periods of heavy rain and longer periods of lighter or no rain). The group perservered, with all players completing their round. The rains changed the character of the course – as the back nine generally plays easier than the front nine. Based on the scores, it appeared that many rounds were derailed a bit – depending on how many holes each group ended up playing during the heavy periods of rainfall.

Of the 36 players and 4 Flights on this day, only 7 players shot net par 71 or lower. 10 players shot net 80 or higher. The low net score of the day belonged to Marcos Silva, the lone guest playing on this day– his net 68 winning the 1st Flight by 1 stroke. This was Marcos' first CGC victory and qualifies him for the 2014 Tournament of Champions (TOC). The other 3 Flights were won with a score of net 70 – Craig Wahlquist won the 2nd Flight via the tie-breaker over Rhonda Johnson, Andrew Dyba won the 3rd Flight by 1 stroke, and Fred Fieldhouse won the 4th Flight by 4 strokes. Craig and Andrew also qualified for the TOC with their victories – while Fred had previously qualified with a Flight victory earlier in the year (Rhonda also qualified previously through tieing for first in her Flight before losing the tie-breaker).
