## Results from Bartley Cavanaugh, October 24, 2015

Bartley Cavanaugh recently celebrated their 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of their opening back in 1995. At a time when many new courses were being built, Bartley has always held onto a special niche in the golf market in the Sacramento area – constructed on a small, square piece of land, and a little shorter than most other courses, with it's main weapons being it's multiple hazards and the weather conditions on any particular day.

This was the CGC's eighth trip to Bartley Cavanaugh (1995, 1996, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2009, 2012). As other local course options came on line in the late 1990's, Bartley fell out of favor as being a little too quirky. As we've brought it back into our rotation in recent years, the more playable length and good value has made it more appealing to the group.

The various sets of tees available at Bartley allows us to provide plenty of good scoring opportunities for all players. The multiple hazards leaves high scores lurking right around the corner at a moments notice – how the golfer deals with the sudden changes of fortune determines how well the final score stacks up. On this lovely Fall day, the 40 players who teed it up did very well – as 21 players shot better than net par 71, while only 3 players finished at net 80 or higher.

## Results from Mather, November 7, 2015

This issue reared its’ head again on this day, as our first group went out almost 30 minutes later than our scheduled tee time. The corresponding back up of groups at various par 3’s out on the course led to kind of an odd ending to our 2015 CGC golfing season – as more of the group than usual was gone by time the last group finished and prizes were announced.

There was nothing to complain about regarding the weather or the golf course, it was a beautiful (and fairly calm) Fall day – and even after a little bit of recent rain, the course played firm and fast, with the greens rolling nicely.
