Results from Plumas Lake, October 1, 2011

October began a little cloudy – it looked a little more like rain than predicted. The temperature was pleasant, however, and by early afternoon the clouds had blown away into a very comfortable afternoon. Plumas Lake again played tough, with only 2 scores under net 70 and 5 overall scores under net par. It appears that the changes to the greens in recent years not only helps the course drainage – but also makes it much more difficult to shoot 'crazy' low scores. The previous greens, which were relatively flat and rolled about as well as any in the area, could definitely yield some low scores if a golfer got in a good rhythm.

The gold set of tees, which we used for the women for just the second time at Plumas Lake, definitely allows the women to be more competitive in their respective flights. With the many creeks to cross throughout the course, bunkers fronting many greens, and the undulating greens – Plumas Lake is still quite a challenge for all levels of golfers.

Shelley Barr had the low net for the day (4 under par net 68) to win the 3rd Flight. Shelley and Stella Garin (1 over par net 73 to win the 2nd Flight) were the day's 2 new qualifiers for the 2012 Tournament of Champions (TOC) event. Jay Simi (2 under par net 69 in the 1st Flight) and Sherry Aceituno (2 under par net 70 in the 4th Flight) had qualified for the TOC previously.

We also want to acknowledge the pace of play of the group. The first 4 groups all finished in under 5 hours – and the longest time of any foursome (5 hours, 12 minutes) was significantly better than in recent events (see following story in this newsletter). Thanks to all for your continued efforts to improve our pace of play. We anticipate this will be a continuing focus for us going forward – and we want to make sure that along the way we acknowledge not only the areas we can improve, but also recognize when the group does a better job of moving around the course.

Pace of Play concerns at CGC Events – continuing discussion

After the 2001 and 2002 CGC golf seasons, we lost a fair number of members who did not rejoin the Club. In many of those instances, the pace of play in our Club events was stated as one of the main reasons for not rejoining.

In early 2003, I was hampered by foot problems – and was unable to play in our first 2 events in 2003. Without advertising it to the group as a whole, I took the opportunity to time our players at those 2 events. Below are the timings I gathered at that time:
